### Safety Plan Agreements:

1. Engage in all scheduled medical appointments with mutually agreed upon providers (Dr. [REDACTED] and Dr. [REDACTED] and any future mutually agreed upon providers in the event additional providers are needed) and follow all treatment recommendations.
2. Complete weight checks as requested by mutually agreed upon provider.

3. The NG tube was removed on 4/8/2022 at the recommendation of Dr. [REDACTED]. If the mutually agreed upon providers feel the NG tube is needed in the future, parents will have a medical professional insert a new NG tube. If the NG tube then comes out, parents have been trained and can re-insert the NG tube. If additional help is needed, they can contact the case manager to coordinate with home health or go to the emergency department.
4. Parents will follow all feeding recommendations made by the mutually agreed upon providers and they will keep a log of feeds and vomiting incidents and provide to IDHW or medical professionals upon request.
5. Parents will allow IDHW into their home as requested and will maintain regular communication with the IDHW case manager including notification of medical appointments.
6. Parents will remain in Ada, Canyon, Elmore, or Gem county.

This agreement is subject to the jurisdiction of the court under the CPA.

Failure to comply with this arrangement may result in the filing of a legal petition and recommendation the child be placed out of the home.
